- Shacharis: 9am (last time to recite shema is 9:17am – please say before davening)
 - Children's Program at 9:15am
 - **Shabbos Rosh Chodesh and Chazzak**
- Special shiur for ladies and girls. Topic: *The Nine Days – Consoling Hashem*, presented by Rabbi Eli Saldinger. When: 5:30pm. Refreshments will be served. (Note, no shiur next Shabbos (Erev Tisha B'av – shiur will resume July 24th).

- Candle Lighting: 8:06pm (sunset at 8:24pm). For those davening with our minyan, please light no later than **7:25pm**.

Shabbos Parshas Devorim/Shabbos Chazon (July 17)

- Shacharis: 9am (last time to recite shema is 9:20am – please say before davening)
 - Children's Program at 9:15am
- Note, no ladies shiur – shiur will resume following Shabbos, July 24th.
- Mincha: **5:45pm**
 - No Pirchei or Shalosh Seudos in shul. Please eat at home. Fast begins 8:23pm. After 9:24pm, say "Baruch Hamavdil Bein Kodesh Lechol" (no regular Havdalah), change out

of leather shoes (+no eating, washing, sitting on regular height seat after this time). May do melacha such as driving to shul at that point.

- Maariv: **10pm** followed by Megilas Eicha. Open for men and ladies.

Sunday/Tisha B'Av (July 18)

- Shacharis: **8:30am (note time change)**. Note, no tallis or tefillin.
