- Mincha: 6:45pm (sunset is 7:08pm)
 - Shiur between mincha and maariv
- Maariv: 7:58pm
- Shabbos ends: 8:09pm (60 minutes after sunset)

- **First night of Selichos – 10pm (Open for Men and Ladies)**

- Shacharis: 8am
