 - Shofar: Approximately 11am
- Gemara Shiur (R' Moshe Weissman): 5:20pm
- Chavrusah learning at 5:50pm
- Mincha: 6:35pm (sunset is 7:01pm). *Learning between Mincha and Maariv*
- Maariv: 7:51pm
- Yom Tov Ends: 8:02pm (R"Y: 8:14pm)

Tzom Gedalia, Monday (Sept. 18)

- Selichos/Shacharis: 5:45am (fast begins 5:17am)
- Mincha: 6:35pm (sunset at 6:59pm) – Maariv to follow.
- Fast ends: 7:34pm (some wait until 7:41pm to eat)
- Remember to do *Tashlich* and *Kapparos* before Yom Kippur

- Mincha/Maariv: 6:45pm

- Shacharis: 9am (Latest time to recite Shema: 9:45am)
 - Children's Program – 9:15am
- Gemara Shiur (R' Moshe Weissman): 5pm
- **Shabbos Shuva Derasha (Open to Men and Ladies): 5:40pm**
- Mincha: 6:25pm (sunset is 6:51pm) followed by shalosh seudos open to men and ladies
- Maariv: 7:41pm (50 min after sunset)
- Shabbos Ends: 7:52pm (R"Y: 8:04pm)

Sunday - Erev Yom Kippur (Sept. 24)

- Selichos/Shacharis: 8am
- Mincha: 2:30pm
- Mitzva to eat today! Eat *seuda hamafsekes*, Mikvah, and bless children
- Remember to carry items to shul before Yom Tov. Remember Kittel. Remember *yur tzeit* candle (as applicable) and to have a candle lit over yom tov to use for Havdalah after yom tov.
- Candle Lighting: 6:31pm (fast begins at sunset: 6:49pm)
- Kol Nidrei: promptly at **6:30pm** (Men may want to come early to say the special prayer, *Tefilas Zaca*, before Kol Nidrei)
- Yom Tov Inspiration from the Rav followed by Maariv

- Eat Shalosh Seudos Before Coming for Mincha

- Maariv: 7:14pm (remember to recite *Vatodienu* during Maariv and make Havdalah during Kiddush)
