High Holidays 5779 Rabbi's message:

Lighting of Holiday Lights (Light Candles) With the setting of this year's evening's sun, united with Jews in every place and every time, we will proclaim a new year of hope. May the light of G-d show us the paths we can follow to do good and create a world of peace. Let the fire we kindle be a warming flame that brings our family closer together and leads us into a year of health and wholeness.

"Seek out G-d when He can be found, call upon Him when He is near" (Isaiah 55:6).

Our Sages interpret this verse as referring to the Aseret Yemei Teshuva, the ten days of repentance, which begin on Rosh Hashanah and end with the conclusion of Yom Kippur. This is the season when G-d is closer to us and thus our prayers stand a "better chance" of success. With the destruction of the Temple, the nature of Yom Kippur underwent a radical change. Yet, nothing really changed at all. It is character development that must be the focus of our efforts on Yom Kippur and throughout the year. That is the way it always was and the way it will always be. May our fasting be of the nature that finds favor in the eyes of G-d.
